#### 臺大教學發展中心

- 1. <u>基礎學科學習諮詢</u>:基礎學科學習諮詢提供**微積分、普通物理、統計學、普通化學** 四個共同基礎科目之諮詢,每日有不同小老師於 **綜合教學館1F 的學習開放空間**駐 點服務。同學可上網預約諮詢時段,若時段已滿也可現場預約。
- 2. <u>專業學科學習諮詢</u>:專業學科學習諮詢由各學系針對系上部分課程提供輔導。每個學期開設學系、科目不同, 依臺大學習諮詢網上公告為準。學生預約方式及相關科目問題請洽各系系辦。
- 3. <u>個案學習諮詢</u>:個案學習諮詢由同學導師向教發中心提出申請後辦理,主要針對前一學期成績預警學生(成績達 1/2 或1/3 不及格之學生)、國際生、體優生與其他特殊需求學生加強課業學習。有需要的同學可主動聯繫導師,將由導師依學生需求客製一對一輔導計畫、招聘小老師提供課業輔導。

1. [Basic Subject Learning Consultation]: Basic subject learning consultation covers Calculus, General Physics, Statistics, and General Chemistry.

Daily services are available with different teaching assistants stationed at the open learning space on **the 1st floor of the Zonghe Lecture Building**. Students can reserve consultation time slots online, and on-site reservations are also accepted.

- 2. [Professional Subject Learning Consultation]: Professional subject learning consultation is offered by various departments for specific courses. The schedule for each semester is subject to the online announcements on the NTU Learning Consultation website. For reservation methods and inquiries regarding specific subjects, please contact the respective department's office.
- 3. <u>[Individualized Learning Consultation]</u>: Individualized learning consultation is initiated by student mentors who apply to the Teaching Development Center. It primarily focuses on students with academic warnings from the previous semester (those achieving half or one-third of passing grades), international students, physically gifted students, and other students with special needs. Students in need can proactively contact their mentors, who will customize a one-on-one tutoring plan and recruit teaching assistants for academic support.
